We cut down small trees, mostly holly and chop them up to form environmentally friendly piles for small mammals and insects; we keep paths clear and help repair damaged trees.

It is not all work, for we break for a coffee/tea with biscuits, usually in the parish office and get to hear the latest news.

We could achieve more if we had more Volunteers. Tescos have done us a favour by instigating a Community Board and this generates quite a bit of interest.

Tools are provided as are gloves.
