This is regards to increasing the number of electric vehicle points across the county. The roll out will likely be in two parts with the first being rolled out in car parks where there is a high number of residential properties nearby. This helps support the shift to increasing the take up of electric vehicles, particularly where residents don't have driveways or the flexibility of having their own electric vehicle charging point installed. The second will focus on car parks generally to provide a good balance of electric vehicle charging points across the county and to support the electric vehicle charging network. If GXCA has a preference of a particular area in Gerrards Cross for the first point of installation, Bucks Council will consider the request.
