A meeting was held with Bucks Officers to clarify items on the GX Parking Consultation. It was agreed that another informal consultation was needed regards parking required in South Park Drive and South Park View area. This can be done in house (no cost) or by TfB (approx. £1500). Once all the amendments have been made it would then go to Formal Consultation (about £6,500). Once agreed, implementation of the new parking scheme could be in the region of £30k but no quote can be provided at this stage.

After the last meeting with Officers at Bucks Council, further clarification is being sought by Buckinghamshire Council for GXTC to install the CCTV cameras to ensure the correct procedures for Method Statements, Pre-Construction Inspection and Traffic Management are in place.
